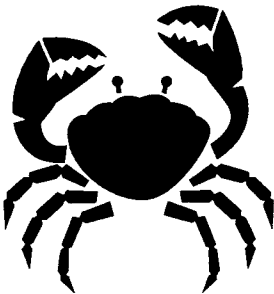

July 30– Alan Jackson; Womens Horseshoes; Cupcake Contest

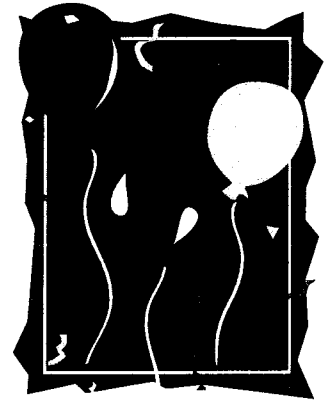

July's Recipe: FRUIT & OAT SQUARES

Ingredients:

2 c. oatmeal

1 c. flour

3/4 c. margarine, melted

1/3 c. brown sugar

1/2 tsp. salt

1/2 tsp. baking soda

1 10-12 oz jar preserves (your favorite flavor, I used raspberry)

Directions:

Heat oven to 350°F. Grease an 11 x 7 glass baking dish. Combine all ingredients except preserves. Mix well. Reserve 3/4 c. oats mixture. Press remaining mixture into bottom of buttered dish. Bake 10 minutes. Spread preserves evenly over partially baked base to within 1/2 inch of sides. Sprinkle with remaining oat mixture.

Bake an additional 20 to 22 minutes or until golden brown. Cool.

Cut into 1" x 1" squares. Store tightly covered at room temperature.

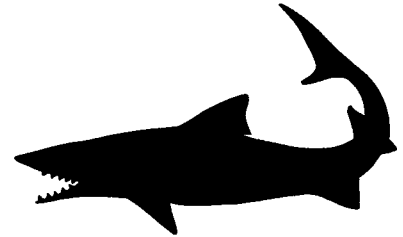
