## Recipe for May: Corn & Crab Poppers



Have a favorite recipe you'd like to share, put it in mailbox 9 for a future newsletter!

Ingredients:

2/3 c. unseasoned bread crumbs, divided 1/2 small red bell pepper 1 can (6 oz) lump crabmeat, drained 1 egg, lightly beaten 1/4 tsp. salt 1/8 tsp. cayenne pepper

3/4 c. thawed frozen corn kernels
1 pkg. fresh chives (about 1/4 c. finely chopped)
1/2 c. mayonnaise, divided
1/2 tsp. coarsely ground black pepper
1 lemon

#### Directions:

Preheat oven ot 425°F. Spray cups of a mini muffin pan with Pam. Sprinkle cups with 1/3 c. of the breadcrumbs, gently tapping and rotating to coat.


Finely chop corn and bell pepper. Blot bell pepper dry with paper towels. Finely chop chives, setting aside 1 Tbsp. for garnish. Combine corn, bell pepper, remaining chives, crabmeat, 1/4 c. of mayo, egg, remaining bread crumbs, salt and pepper in a large bowl. Mix well.

Divide crab mixture evening among cups of pan. Bake 8-10 minutes or until golden brown. Remove from oven, cool poppers in pan for two minutes. Remove from pan and put on cooling rack. For sauce to top them with:

Combine 1 tsp. lemon juice, cayenne pepper and 1/4 c. mayo in a small bowl. Mix well. Top poppers with sauce and reserved chives.
